



## Indian Spring Golf Course

### Local Rules

---

- All naturalized and burned areas on the golf course are to be played as ground under repair, and you may obtain free relief. These areas are obviously identifiable and your entire group must agree before relief is taken.
- Ditch on #1 and #15 are not hazards and you may take free relief.
- All roads and cart paths are entitled to free relief.

#### **Out of Bounds is defined on the following holes: (Rule 27)**

- Hole #4, 5, 6 White Stakes define O.B. on left side
- Hole #7: Driving Range Net defines O.B. If your golf ball lies against the fence, there is NO free relief. The first and last post define the starting and ending of Out of Bounds on Hole #7.
- Hole #8: The driving range fence along the left side and O.B. stakes define out of bounds.
- Hole #9: Elmwood Road, the parking lot, and the white fence around the back of the green.
- Hole #11: Left side defined by white stakes
- The Center for the Arts and the Clubhouse are Out of Bounds, including the paved cart paths behind the 18<sup>th</sup> green.

#### **Water Hazards defined by Yellow Stakes (Rule 26)**

- Left side of #1 Fairway
- In front of #5 green
- In front of #6 green
- Right side of #10 fairway, near green
- #13 short of the green
- Splitting the fairway on #18 and the pond off the tee

#### **Lateral Water Hazards defined by Red Stakes (Rule 26)**

- Left side of #5 beginning at the dogleg of the fairway and continuing down the whole left side of the fairway
- Behind #8 Green
- Left of #9 Green
- Entire left side of #10 fairway and behind #10 green
- Right side of #10 fairway
- Left side of #12 fairway
- Right of #13 green
- Left side and right side of #14
- The area between #16 and #17
